## **STOP** Closure of Your Waterville Airport



Kings Council will close **YOUR** airport on September 30<sup>th</sup>

### **Your Waterville airport:**

- Is the 2<sup>nd</sup> busiest airport in Nova Scotia.
- Provides full time employment for 20 people and
- Spin off employment for 100+ more in the county and beyond.
- Brings in over **1.2 million** for a subsidy of \$60,000
- Provides pilot training for commercial and other airlines including Air Canada, Westjet, Canjet and Porter
- Provides a serviced landing strip with facilities for Medevac, DNR, and business aircraft.
- Provides an provincial entryway for **fly-in tourists** from across North America.
- Provides a landing strip in the event of an emergency for small to medium aircraft
- Provides a waypoint and possible refueling stop for pilot training from Moncton.
- Provides a base for a Parachute Jump School that attracts people from Nova Scotia and elsewhere
- Provides recreational flying and tourist sight-seeing flights

# The Reason for the closure claimed by the Municipality of Kings Council is to provide land for the REMOTE POSSIBLITY of Michelin plant expansion! But....

#### Michelin Canada:

- Could expand in directions other than north onto airport lands
- Has **NOT** guaranteed any such expansion within the next 1 to 10 years.
- Has not signed a Memorandum of Understanding with KINGS Council
- Has let **200** go from its Granton plant and will let a further **300** go in 2015
- Must compete for expansion with other Michelin plants in North America especially in South Carolina where power, land and labour are cheap

## What will happen if the airport is closed?

Land for the relocation of your airport will be difficult to find and it is expensive to rebuild an airport. (Estimates are in the 10 million dollar range). CFB Greenwood **cannot** accommodate a full service public airport.

Closing the 70+ year old Waterville airport will destroy a small but valuable economic asset. Your airport MUST NOT BE ALLOWED TO CLOSE!
